

Scholarship Mined Land Reclamation Educational Grant Program

Award:

The NASLR Scholarship Award will be a \$2,000 check presented to the winner at the awards banquet at the annual conference. Fees will be waived for the scholarship winner to attend the awards banquet. If the scholarship winner is unable to attend the conference and/or awards banquet, then alternative arrangements will be made.

Criteria:

- ❖ Applicant must be a full-time junior, senior or graduate student as required by the accredited college or university currently being attended.
- ❖ The final degree being sought must be one that is directly related to mined land reclamation as judged by the Awards Committee.
- ❖ One grant in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to the selected applicant prior to the Fall Term of the upcoming school year.
- Other factors being equal, preference will be given to applicants from NASLR member states or those attending colleges or universities in states that are members of NASLR.

Applications must be received by July 1 of each year to be considered for that year's award. Please submit the applications via email(s) of 5MB or less to the contact listed on the web page.
